## Important Notes on Spelling Rules for Regular Verbs

Rule	Example
Most verbs: add <b>-ed</b>	work → worked
Verbs ending in <b>-e</b> : add <b>-d</b>	like → liked
Verbs ending in consonant + <b>-y</b> : change <b>y</b> → <b>i</b> + <b>-ed</b>	carry → carried
One-syllable verb (CVC): double final consonant + <b>-ed</b>	stop → stopped
Verbs ending in <b>-c</b> : add <b>-ked</b>	panic → panicked
